542. NK-Jehoahaz succeeded his father Jehu as king over Israel in the twenty-third year of Joash, the son of Ahaziah. He reigned seventeen years {#2Ki 13:1} and during that entire time Hazael, the king of Syria, cruelly oppressed the Israelites, {#2Ki 13:3,7,22} as foretold by Elisha. {#2Ki 8:12}

3163c AM, 3873 JP, 841 BC 38 SK, 16 NK

543. SK-Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, was made viceroy with his father toward the end of the thirty-seventh year of Joash, king of Judah. He reigned sixteen years. {#2Ki 13:10}

3165c AM, 3875 JP, 839 BC, 40,1 SK, 3 NK

546. NK-When Jehoahaz, the son of Jehu, had reigned seventeen years, he died and was buried in Samaria. {#2Ki 13:1,9}
