487. SK-Abijah, the son of Rehoboam, succeeded his father, who died in the beginning of the eighteenth year of Jeroboam's reign. He reigned three years. {#1Ki 15:1,2 2Ch 13:1,2} [L62]

488. SK-Abijah and his army of four hundred thousand men fought with Jeroboam and his army of eight hundred thousand men. Because Abijah trusted in God, he was victorious against Jeroboam. He killed half a million of Jeroboam's soldiers. This was the highest casualty rate of any battle recorded in the Bible. Abijah captured the following cities: Bethel, where one of the calves was set up, Jeshanah and Ephraim, along with their associated towns. {#2Ch 13:1-22}

489. SK-After Abijah's death, and at the very end of the twentieth year of Jeroboam's reign in Israel, Asa succeeded his father Abijah and reigned forty-one years. {#1Ki 15:8-10}
