**3163c AM, 3873 JP, 841 BC 38 SK, 16 NK**

**543. SK-Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, was made viceroy with his father toward the end of the thirty-seventh year of Joash, king of Judah. He reigned sixteen years. {#2Ki 13:10}**

**3165c AM, 3875 JP, 839 BC, 40,1 SK, 3 NK**

**546. NK-When Jehoahaz, the son of Jehu, had reigned seventeen years, he died and was buried in Samaria. {#2Ki 13:1,9} Shortly after his father's funeral, Joash visited Elisha, the prophet, who was lying on his death bed. Tearfully, he asked counsel of him concerning the state of the kingdom. Elisha foretold that he would have three victories over the Syrians. {#2Ki 13:14-20}**

**3178 AM, 3888 JP, 826 BC 14 SK, 16 NK**

**550. NK-Joash defeated Amasiah, king of Judah, and took him prisoner. He broke down six hundred feet of the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate. When he had taken all the treasure from both the temple and the king's house, he returned to Samaria. {#2Ki 14:13,14 2Ch 25:23,24}**

**3179c AM, 3889 JP, 825 BC, 15 SK, 1 NK**

**551. Joash died fifteen years before the death of Amaziah. Jeroboam II, his son, succeeded him and reigned in Samaria for forty-one years. {#2Ki 14:23}**
