567. NK-Zachariah, the son of Jeroboam II, began his reign in the thirty-eighth year of Uzziah, king of Judah. He was the fourth and last of the family of Jehu, as was foretold by God. He reigned for six months. {#2Ki 15:8,12 10:30}

568. At the end of those six months, he was murdered by Shallum the son of Jabesh, before all the people. {#2Ki 15:10} It was at this time that the calamities foretold by Amos the prophet took place: {#Am 7:9}

"The high places of Isaac shall be desolate and the sanctuaries of Israel made a wilderness, when I shall arise with a sword against the house of Jeroboam."

- 569. Shallum, the son of Jabesh, reigned one month in the thirty-ninth year of Uzziah, king of Judah. {#2Ki 15:13}
- 570. When Menahem, the son of Gad, was going from Tirzah to Samaria, he killed Shallum and destroyed Tiphsah with its borders. He also violently slaughtered all the pregnant women. {#2Ki 15:14,16}
